#### Tangy Honey Glazed Ham

#### 1 10 lb Ham-Spiral or Non-Spiral Ham

#### **Glaze**

1 1/4 C Packed Brown Sugar 1/3 C Pineapple Juice 1/3 C Honey 1/2 Large Orange 2 Tbls Dijon Mustard 1/4 tsp Ground Cloves 1 1/2 tsp Lemon Juice

Preheat oven 325-Place ham on a rack in a roasting pan. Bake uncovered for 2 hours. While ham is baking, combine brown sugar, pineapple juice and honey in a saucepan. Zest orange into saucepan (I like lots of zest) then squeeze in the juice. Add Dijon mustard and ground cloves; whisk mixture over medium-high heat as it comes to a boil. Reduce heat and simmer until glaze slightly thickens. 5 to 10 minutes, set aside. After 2 hours brush ham with glaze and then every 10 minutes for 30 to 40 minutes. I like to cook a spiral ham and brush the glaze between the spirals.

I cooked this for our Christmas Party and there was not any left for soup the next day.
